# Mobilizing the Incarcerated for Great Commission

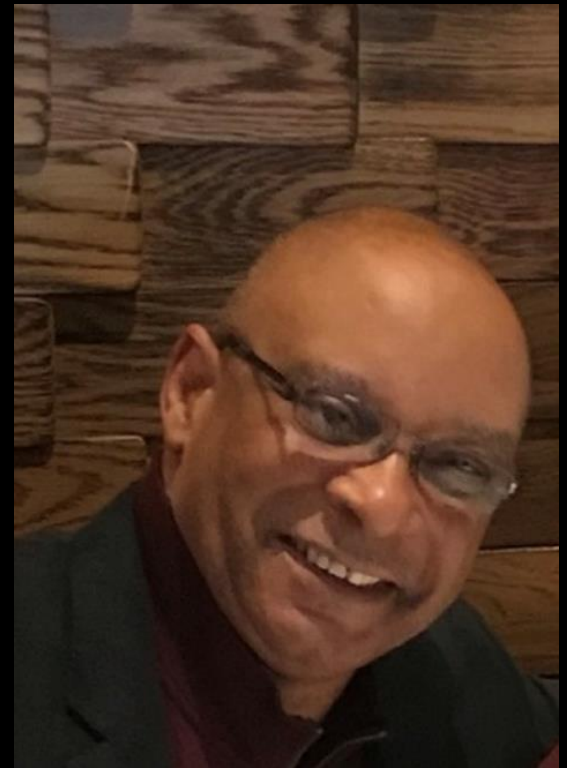
- Closed countries

# Prison to People-group Pipeline

## Re-enculturation

1. Prison has a culture different than on the outside
2. The primary reason for recidivism not character but culture (can't adjust to life on the outside)
3. Church is key to re-enculturation

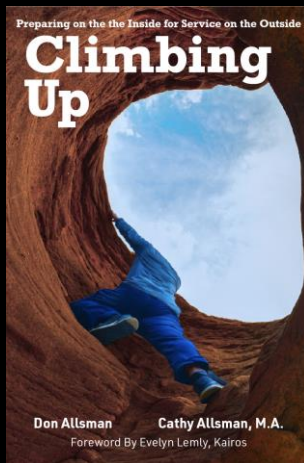
